NOTIFICATION

No.4-13/96-Admn/Law/3220-3/. The Government of Balochistan, Law & Parliamentary Affairs Department, with prior approval of the Competent Authority is pleased to appoint Mr. Mohammad Ayaz Khan Advocate as Additional Advocate General at Islamabad on contract basis for a period of one year with immediate effect on the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Pay
1. Retainer ship Rs. 30,000/- per month
 2. Non Practicing Allowance Rs. 50,000/- per month
 3. Accommodation or House Rs. 20,000/- per month if accommodation is not provided
 4. Fee for all work before the Supreme Court of Pakistan Rs.6,000/- per day
 5. Fee in Criminal Case in High Court Rs. 800/-per case per day
 6. Civil work cases Rs. 600/-per case per appearance
 7. Fee for misc: work including writ petition Rs. 600/- per case per appearance
 8. Telephone
 - Office no limit.
 - Residence 1500/- calls per month
 - (Cellular phones) Rs.3,000/- per month
 9. Transport 1000 CC Car for official use with 175 Liters POL per month or in case of non availability of staff car a conveyance allowance Rs.10,000/- per month.
 10. TA/DA As admissible to grade-21 officers.
 11. Medical Facility As admissible to grade-21 officers.
 12. Private Practice No private practice of any kind shall be allowed.

13. Leave

The Additional Advocate General shall be eligible for leave as follows:-

- Leave on pay equivalent to full pay may be granted upto 1/11th of the period spend on duty as Additional Advocate General, provided that leave of this kind shall not accumulate beyond four months.
- Leave on medical grounds may be granted on pay equivalent to half up to 2/11th of the period spent on duty as Additional Advocate General, subject to a maximum of three months at a time.
- Extra Ordinary Leave may be granted without pay and allowances subject to a maximum of six months at a time.
- Leave of various kinds may be granted in combination up to a maximum of six months at a time.
- For the first one year of the appointment, the Additional Advocate General will not be entitled to more than one month leave except on medical grounds.

14. Termination of Contract

The Contract shall be liable to termination at any time before the expiry of the aforementioned period:-

- i) On one month's notice from either side or payment of one month's pay in lieu thereof;
- ii) If he is found to be guilty of misconduct, inefficient, neglect or failure of duty and;
- iii) If he is found to be unfit on medical grounds.
