A Regulation to apply certain laws to the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas of <sup>2</sup>Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS is the expedient to apply certain laws to the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas of Balochistan;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, may, with respect to any matter within the legislative competence of the Provincial Assembly, make regulations for a Provincially Administered Tribal Area or any part thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf. the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, is pleased to make the following Regulation:-

Short title, extent and Commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas (Application of Laws) Regulation, 1984.

(2) It extends to the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas of Balochistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Application of laws to the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas.

2. The Laws specified in the Schedule to this Regulation, as in force in Balochistan immediately before the commencement of this Regulation, and, so far as may be, all rules, notifications and orders which may have been, or may be, made or issued thereunder, shall apply to the Provincially Administered Tribal Areas of Balochistan, hereinafter referred to as said Areas.

Certain Laws to cease to

3. (1) If, immediately before the commencement of this Regulation, there was in force in the said Areas any Law,

operate.

instrument, custom or usage having the force of law corresponding to the provisions of the laws applied to the said Areas by this Regulation, such law instrument, custom or usage shall, upon such commencement, cease to have effect in the said Areas.

- (2) Nothing in sub-section (1) shall affect—
- (a) the previous operation of such law, instrument, custom or usage; or
  - (b) any obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence punishable under such law, instrument, custom or usage; or
  - (c) any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment;

and any such investigation, proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continue or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if sub-section (1) had not come into force.
