A Regulation to extend the Good Conduct Prisoners Probational Release Act, 1926 (Punjab Act X of 1926), to the Tribal Areas of Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the Good Conduct Prisoners' Probational Release Act, 1926 (Punjab Act X of 1926), to the Tribal Areas of Balochistan;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by clause (4) of Article 247 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan<sup>3</sup>, the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Regulation, namely:—

Short title, extent and commencemen t.

- 1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Good Conduct Prisoners' Probational Release Act (Extension to Tribal Area of Balochistan) Regulation, 1974.
- (2) It extends to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.
  - (3) It shall come into force at once.

2. The provisions of the Good Conduct Prisoners' Probational Release Act, 1926 (Punjab Act X of 1926), and the rules made thereunder shall apply to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan as they apply to the other Areas of the Province.
