A Regulation to apply the Probation of Offenders Ordinance, 1960 (XLV of 1960), to the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the provisions of the ³Probation of Offenders Ordinance, 1960 (XLV of 1960), and the rules made thereunder from time to time, to the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the 25th day of March, 1969, read with the Proclamation of the 20th day of December, 1971 and the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan, with the previous approval of the President, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Regulation, namely: —

Short title, extent and commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Probation of Offenders Ordinance (Application to Tribal Areas of Balochistan) Regulation, 1972.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Application of Probation of Offenders Ordinance, 1960, to the Tribal Areas of Balochistan.

2. The provisions of the Probation of Offenders Ordinance, 1960 (XLV of 1960), and the rules made thereunder shall apply to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan as they apply to the other areas of the Province.
