**1[THE EXCISE REGULATION (2BALOCHISTAN AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1984**

(Balm Ordinance X of 1984)

An Ordinance further to amend the excise Regulation,
1915.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the excise Regulation, 1915 (I of 1915), in its application to the Province of Balochistan for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with the Article 2 of Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (C.M.L.A. Order No. 1 of 1981), the Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

Short title and
commencement

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Excise Regulation (Balochistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

(3) It shall extend to whole of Province of Balochistan except tribal areas.

Addition of Section
27-A, in
Regulation I of
1915.

2. In the Excise Regulation, 1915, after Section 27, a new Section shall be added, namely:-

“27-A. Prohibition for Muslims :- No licence, permit or pass under this Regulation shall be issued to a Muslim”.
