An Ordinance to amend the Forest Act, 1927.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to certain parts of the Province of West Pakistan, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Presidential Proclamation of the seventh day of October, 1958, and having received the previous instructions of the President, the Governor of West Pakistan, in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be called the Forest (West Pakistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1962.

Substitution of the word "vehicles" for the word "carts".

2. In the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of West Pakistan, except the Districts of Dadu, Hyderabad, Tharparkar, Upper Sind Frontier, Larkana, Nawab Shah, Sanghar and Sukkur, ²[Karachi Division] and the ³[Tribal Areas], for the word "carts" wherever it occurs the word "vehicles" shall be substituted.
