NOTIFICATION.

No. SOR(5)7/S&GAD-80/_____. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 25 of the Balochistan Civil Servants Act, 1974 (IX of 1974), the Government of Balochistan is pleased to make the following rules prescribing the syllabus and other matters in respect of the departmental examination required to be passed by Tehsildars, under rule 8 and sub-rule (4) of rule 10 of the Balochistan Tehsildari Service Rule, 1980, namely :-

PART-I GENERAL.

1. **Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Balochistan Tehsildari Departmental Examination Rules, 1983.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. **Definitions.** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires the following expression shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them that is to say :-

- (a) "Commission" means the Balochistan Public Service Commission.
- (b) "Examination" means the Departmental Examination of Tehsildars.
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Balochistan.
- (d) "Member" means the Senior Member, Board of Revenue, Incharge of Administration.
- (e) "Service" means the Balochistan Tehsildari Service.

PART-II EXAMINATION.

○ **Date and place of examination.** The examination shall be held twice a year on the dates and places, notified by the Commission in the official Gazette at least two months before the date of such examination.

4. **Eligibility.** (1) A person selected for recruitment to the Service in the rank of Tehsildar (hereinafter in this part referred to as 'Candidate') shall be eligible to appear in the examination under this part.

(2) No candidate who fails to pass the examination under this part:

(a) within two years from the date of his selection in the case of persons selected by initial recruitment;

Or

within one year from the date of his selection in the case of persons selected otherwise;

Shall be eligible to appear at a subsequent examination except with the permission in writing from the Member.

(3) A Naib Tehsildar who has passed the Naib Tehsildari examination, will be eligible to appear in the examination without any restriction as to the period, and the number of attempts.

5. **Authority for conducting examination.** The examination shall be conducted by the commission.

6. **Procedure for appearance in the examination.** (1) The candidate who intend to appear in the examination shall submit their applications through such authority within such time and in such manner and from as may be prescribed from time to time by the Commission.

(2) The candidate intending to appear in the examination shall indicate their intention/medium at the time of submission of their applications under sub-rule (1). Only such candidates shall be allowed to appear in the examination.

7. **Syllabus.** (1) There shall be combined examination for Assistant Commissioner and Tehsildars i.e. the papers for the Tehsildari examination shall be the same as for the Assistant Commissioners, but the candidates intending to appear for this examination only shall not be required to answer paper on Jail, or to appear in the paper on Treasury.

(2) The examination shall be conducted in the following subjects;-

(3) The papers shall be set and marks assigned to each subject/paper in accordance with the syllabus prescribed for the examination of Assistant Commissioners. The paper of Patwar Mensuration will be of 30 marks only with two hours duration.

8. **Authority to grant grace marks.** The Chairman of the Commission may, at his discretion, grant grace marks in special cases at 4 percent of the marks obtained by the candidate in each paper in which he has failed to prevent hardship to an individual.
9. **Qualifying Standard.** The minimum number of marks for passing the examination each subject/paper shall be forty percent of the minimum marks allocated to that subject/paper.
10. **Failures.** A candidate who fails to secure the minimum number of marks prescribed under rule 9 in any subject/paper may, subject to the provisions of rule 4 appear in that subject/paper in subsequent examination.
11. **Publication of result.** The result of candidates who have passed the examination shall be notified and published in the official Gazette by the Commission. The marks obtained by the candidate shall also be indicated in the result.
12. **Permission to consult books.** (1) The papers to be answered with the aid of reference books shall be Criminal Law papers I & II, Civil Law, Revenue Law Paper-1 and Local Government. Only the bare Acts will be allowed in the examination.

(2) The papers which are to be answered with the aid of books shall not be such as can be answered by copying a passage from a book, but shall be designed to test the practical knowledge of the candidates and shall be confined as much as possible to cases arising in ordinary practice, facts of probable occurrence being stated, and the candidates required to find and apply the law bearing on them.
13. **Disqualification.** No writing of any kind shall be brought by the candidates in the examination room any copying from the paper of other candidate resorted to in the examination, and any candidate found violating this rule

shall render himself liable to disqualification for appearing in the examination in future and in addition he will be punished under the Balochistan Civil Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 1981.

14. **Repeal.** The west Pakistan Tehsildari and Naib Tehsildari Departmental Examination and Training Rules, 1969, so far as they relate to the departmental examination of Tehsildars are hereby repealed.
