An Act to amend the Conciliation Courts Ordinance, 1961.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Conciliation Courts Ordinance, 1961;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title and commencemen t.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Conciliation Courts (West Pakistan Amendment) Act, 1969;
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 8 of Ordinance No. XLIV of 1961.

- 2. In the Conciliation Courts Ordinance, 1961, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 8, after sub-section (2), the following new sub-section shall be added, namely:—
 - "(2-a) In the commutation of the period of thirty days provided under sub-section (2) for making an application, the provisions of sections 5 and 12 of the Limitation Act, 1908 (Act IX of 1908) shall apply."

Amendment of section 16 of Ordinance No. XLIV of 1961.

- 3. In sub-section (2) of section 16 of the said Ordinance:—
 - (a) between the word "court" and the word "is", the words and comma "is unable to appear personally due to any disability, or" be inserted; and
 - (b) for the word "her" the words "such person" be substituted.
