An Ordinance further to amend the Forest Act, 1927
(XVI of 1927).

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief Executive's Order No. 9 of 1999), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: –

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Forest (Balochistan Amendment) Ordinance, 2001.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 67 of Act XVI of 1927.

2. In the Forest Act, 1927, in section 67, the words “District Magistrate or any” shall be deleted.
