A Regulation to apply certain provincial labour laws to the tribal areas of the Province of Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the provisions of certain provincial labour laws and the rules made thereunder from time to time, to the tribal areas of the Province of Balochistan.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by clause (4) of Article 247 of the Constitution³ of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Regulation, namely: —

Short title, extent and commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Provincial Labour Laws (Application to the Tribal Areas of Balochistan) Regulation, 1974.

(2) It extends to the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Application of certain provincial labour laws to the tribal areas of the Province of Balochistan.

2. The provisions of the Provincial labour laws set forth in the Schedule to this Regulation, and the rules, orders, notifications, bye-laws or directions made or issued thereunder from time to time, shall apply to the tribal areas of the province of Balochistan as they apply to the other areas of the Province.
