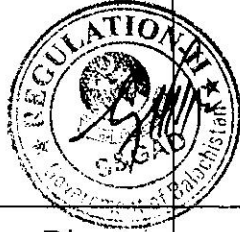
In the aforesaid rules, for the existing Appendix, the following shall be substituted, namely,-
